There are major issues you want to know about before calling prospective Disc Jockeys.

Date, time and location. A 4 hour event is not always the same, and rates can vary on ALL 3 items. A 4 hour event on a Saturday night is probably more expensive than a Sunday afternoon. Since many DJs will work multiple events on any given day, availability may be an issue if your event takes up both afternoon AND evening slots such as 4:00 - 8:00. Likewise, if your event is from 7:00 - 11:00, and your DJ is booked from 1:00 - 5:00, it may be problematic if that customer decides to extend their time to 6:00 OR you need him earlier.

Think about what type of personality you want-low key, master of ceremonies or high profile. Keep in mind this has nothing to do with the type of music! Please see our Frequently Asked Questions to see which personality is best for you. Some DJs do not work well with extensive pre-selected request lists, while others do. Also, some DJs will not let you pick more than a few songs. Convey to your prospective DJ whether you will:

- A) pick out all or most of your music
- B) want your DJ to use his experience to play the best possible music for your guests and take requests
- C) pick out some music AND let the DJ use his experience and take requests

Here Are Some Issues Many DJ's Do Not Want You To Know. . .

SALES, DISCOUNTS AND HIGH PRESSURE TACTICS

"We are having a sale that ends this Friday." What you won't be told is that there will be another "sale" within a week. A sale is not a sale if they have it weekly! "...but for just a few dollars more, we will upgrade you." Most intelligent people would never try to save money on the lower end service on such an important day. These unethical tactics are used to pressure you into a quick, uninformed decision. This tactic leads you to believe that you are getting the same service as everyone else for less, which is NOT true.

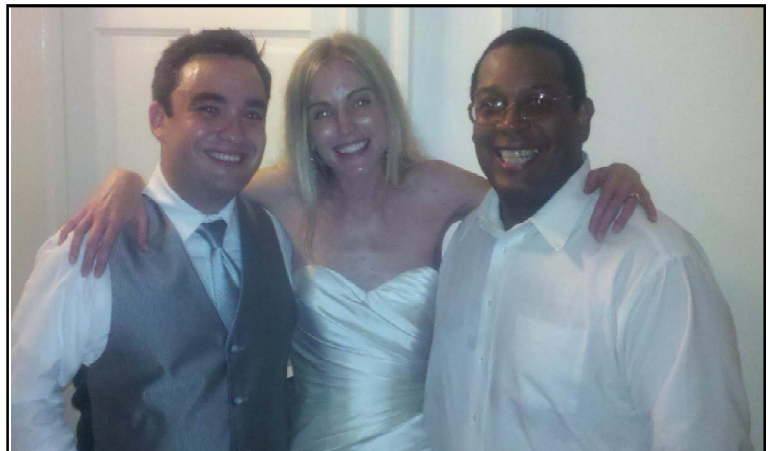
WEB SITES

Some DJs do not even have a web site! Since there are free web hosting sites everywhere, this should not be an issue. If they are serious about their business, a professional DJ should have professional material, equipment and just as important - an informative web site. If they are not "good with computers" they probably cannot troubleshoot the complex DJ equipment and that can be a major issue.

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

With today's technology, there is absolutely no reason why a DJ should not be using digital media such as CDs or MP3s. The most reliable source is CDs (which IS digital). MP3 is great, however it depends on how it was recorded. 96 Kbps (FM radio) is unacceptable quality. Some DJs download their music from the internet (legally and illegally), and never know the source from which it was recorded. And some rip (copy) from CDs and do not even know what quality their music has been recorded.

I call this my hurricane wedding. We had a very bad weather and everyone still showed up and had a great time. What a great party. I even had a generator just in case we lost power. The only problem was it was hot, hot, hot, hot. I was setup in a corner. Groom - Ricardo, Bride - Julie and me. We took this photo at the end of the reception.



THE DJ INTERVIEW

Although it is important to talk to your DJ before the event, do not think that an interview with a DJ will give you any insight about a DJ! If that were true, we would simply tell you to come in and interview a DJ. A meeting doesn't give you any insight of the DJ's musical capabilities (ability to read a crowd), organizational skills, reliability to follow instructions, etc. One advantage of hiring a company is that they know the strengths and weaknesses of each DJ. The biggest complaint customers have with DJs is "I told him to do something and he didn't do it. Some DJs will simply "do their own thing" at your event and this is not what you want.

EXPERIENCE EXPERIENCE EXPERIENCE

Do not risk hiring an inexperienced DJ just to save a few dollars. A polished professional can calmly deal with the nervous family member, or a crowd that just won't dance, while keeping the event enjoyable. Make sure the DJ will be experienced at YOUR type of event. Do your DJs drink alcohol on the job? This can be a legitimate concern. A professional DJ will not drink or smoke on the job. **Make sure to ask about the drinking and smoking policies of the DJ services you are considering.**

RELIABLE FULL-TIME COMPANIES

DJ companies come and go every year! Similarly, new DJ web sites pop up on the internet every week and shopping by internet alone will give you only 1/2 of the story. Even today, the web is not all encompassing, and you may be missing out on a lot of vital information. Remember, DJs perform a customer service, and how they handle your initial consultation can give great insight into how they work as a whole.

THE "BEST" DJs

Why would anyone EVER want anything less than the company's "best" DJ? Be cautious of services who package their DJs as "SUPERB" or "DELUXE". Classifying some DJs as "more popular" than others is a tactic to have you pay more money. Don't be suckered into their idea of what is a "good" - it may be drastically different than yours. Conversely, if only a handful of their DJs are labeled as "BETTER", just what does that really say about the remaining ones? To avoid a bait and switch - get these names in advance, and specific references for those DJs.

YOUR CHOICE OF PERSONALITY

Some events require a heavy interaction, while others like to have a DJ that will just remain in the background. Most prefer someone in between or - a moderate personality (also described as a master of ceremonies). The type of personality should be your choice. The best thing to do is tell the company what you want, then let them schedule the DJ best suited for you. Then talk to your assigned DJ as your special day gets closer. Watch out for words like "fun" and "good"- these are very subjective. Always be as specific as possible regarding what you want.

BACKUP DJs AND BACKUP EQUIPMENT

What if your DJ is sick or is involved in an accident? Is that a gamble you want to take on your special day? Independent DJs and small companies with less than 3 DJs on staff are the highest risks since they will usually book all their DJs, leaving you without a backup! TIP: If there is no backup, a common response you may get is: "We have NEVER had a problem," or "I work with several DJs (network of DJs) that will be on backup for me." Both of these answers means they do NOT have backup! In addition, make sure that your DJ will be using professional grade equipment, including compact discs and wireless microphones.

Suggested Timing For Weddings

Cocktails: First event - as guests arrive. NOTE: This is NOT the same time as arrival of guests (bride & groom will still be at the church taking pictures). Guests are known to simply arrive right after the ceremony regardless of your official time on the invitation.

Note: Often, cocktails are held in a separate area than dinner & dancing. If this is the case, we can provide music during this time, however our setup must be within 75 feet for us to be able to put 1 speaker in that area which we can later retract into the main room.

Introductions: Announced after cocktails and before dinner. DJ will line up those who need to be introduced and announce each couple into the dining area.

Blessing: Made before dinner. Sometimes this is replaced by a welcome speech.

Toast: Before dinner OR with cake cutting. Usually done by the Best Man and/or Maid of Honor

Meal: Served after blessing or toast



The new Mrs. Olga Chen with DJ Ben Howard. Her time line was a bit different. Actually today there is no set time line. We set up everything the way the bride and groom wants it done and can still stay within your budget. While we are professional, we are fun and your guest will have a great time.

First Dance: Can be done A) immediately after introductions, then go into blessing, toast and meal OR B) after the meal with 2nd and 3rd dances.

Typical combinations are as follows (for song recommendations, see list below):

Bride & Groom

Bride & Groom, then bridal party midway through song

Bride & Groom, then open dance floor midway through song

Second Dance: Can be done A) after the 1st dance OR B) after the meal to smoothly transition into open dancing.

Typical combinations are as follows (for song recommendations, see list below):

Bride & Father

Bride & Father, Groom & Mother midway through song

Bride & Father- then open dance floor midway

Groom-Mother entire song

Bridal Party, open dance floor to all guests

NOTE: Once you open the dance floor to all guests, it is a good idea to keep them there - do NOT go into another dance or special event or you will lose the momentum to keep people up and dancing.

Cake Cutting: Cut roughly 1 hour after dinner

Bouquet Toss: Immediately after cake cutting (while cake is being cut)

Garter Removal: Immediately after bouquet toss

Garter Replacement: Immediately after garter removal

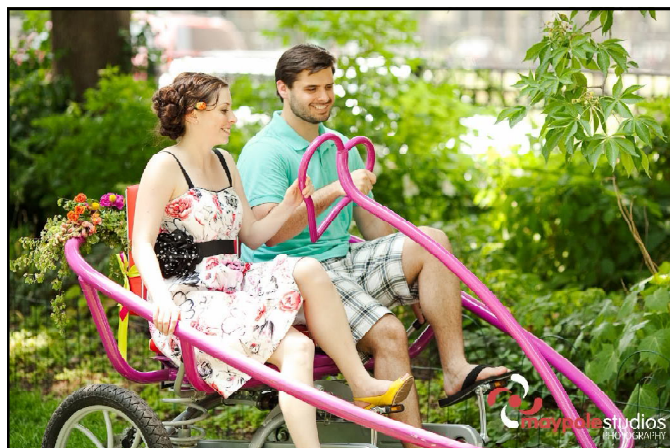

use; an artwork to ride, inspired by hotrods and valentines.

Photo booth General Questions

What is your deposit? 50% of the rental fee. The balance is due 30 days before your event. We accept Visa and Mastercard as well as checks and money orders.

Do you charge extra for set up of your booths? No, we will arrive 1.5 hours to set up the booth and then take it away at the end of the event.

I need the booth set up two hours before my reception because my ceremony and reception are at the same place. How much do you charge for idle hours? This happens quite frequently. We charge \$30 extra per hour of idle time. Some customers choose to have the booth run for a one hour cocktail hour. Have it idle for an hour during dinner and then have it run for a couple more hours during the reception as well.

How many sessions does your booth take per hour & how many pictures does your booth take per hour? This is a question that a lot of clients are confused about! Our photobooths take four photos per session. We can do about 50 sessions an hour. After each session the four photos are printed out on a single sheet of photo paper. So the booth takes a total of around 200 photos per hour. Some companies have booths that do 6 photos per session. Because each session takes longer though they can only do around 35-40 sessions per hour and thus less people get to use the booth per hour. Bigger is not always better. While we can program our booths to do any number of photos, we have found that four is the perfect balance between efficiency and letting people just have fun. If you have a special situation that requires a high volume of people to go through the booth in a short amount of time we recommend renting two booths or simply having a single picture per session.

Do we get unlimited photos during the rental period? Yes and no. So many companies brag about "unlimited" photos. Tell them you want 200 photos printed out per hour though and see what happens. There actually is a limit to the number of photos you can make whether you rent from us or the competition. The limit is because it is just humanly impossible to have more than around 70 sessions per hour. People need 40 to 60 seconds to get into the booth and take their photos. So to answer the question, yes we give you unlimited photos, just realize that in the real world that means 50 to 70 sessions per hour.

I have 200 guests at my wedding, how many hours should I rent the booth for? Generally speaking people go in the booth in groups or at the very least couples. Sure there's your third cousin who couldn't get a date, but we're talking about normal people here :) If all 200 of your guests came as couples then you'd need 100 sessions and since our booth does about 50 sessions per hour you'd need a minimum of two hours for every couple to get a print out. However many people go in twice and then there's your other cousin who is a totally camera hog and goes in there 5 times :) Taking that into consideration we recommend at least an hour and a half for every 100 guests invited. For 200 guests that would be at least 3 hours. We've been to smaller weddings where everyone is constantly using it while we've also gone to larger weddings where there were so many activities it caused less usage. You'll have to use a bit of your own judgment to determine how long you want it.



Our reception venue is on the side of a mountain. To get there you need to go up 100 steps and across a swinging bridge and there's no electricity. Will that be a problem? No, our booths are easily transported, weigh 70 pounds and come in a rolling case and you can rent a generator from us for an extra fee.

How much floor space will the booth take up? Will you need anything besides electricity? Is it wheelchair accessible? 3.5'x 5.5 feet. It fits 4 comfortably, but we've seen 12 or more people crammed up in it. If you purchase the guest book option, a small rectangular table will be needed as well as a chair for people to sign the guestbook. It is wheelchair accessible. Our booth is unique in that the bench can be removed and people in wheel chairs can then use the booth.

I've seen some companies that need a separate table for a computer printer and notebook computer, which seems to take up a lot of space. Does your company require that? For our standard photo printouts no extra table is needed.

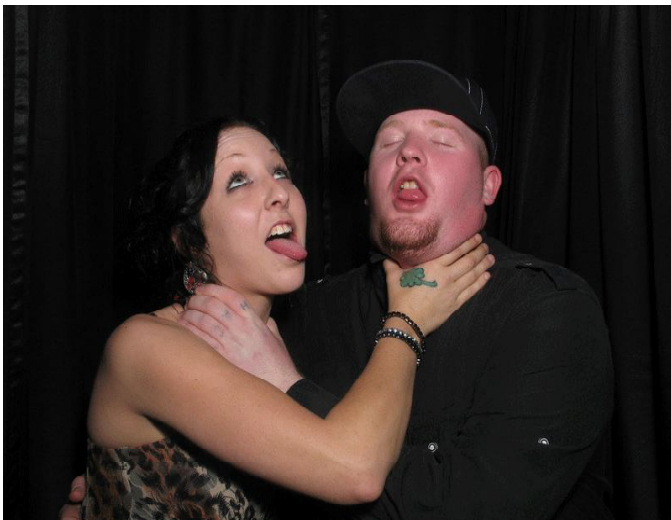
How long does it take for photos to be posted on the internet? Can they be password protected? Two weeks or less and yes most galleries are password protected.

Can we get a copy of the images taken by the digital photobooth on a disk? Yes all photobooth rentals include a CD or DVD of all the photos taken at high resolution, which will allow you to make enlargements up to and beyond 16x20" easily.

Can you print out the classic 4 strip black and white photos like the old 1950's photo booths do? Are there other options for how the photos are printed? Yes we can print the strips out in black and white or color. If you choose the photos strips then the machine prints out two 4x6" strips on a sheet. This is a very popular option for people that want a scrapbook guest book. The guests keep one strip and the other strip goes into the scrap book.

What is a green screen Photo booth? Instead of using a normal background we use a green screen background and virtually add any background our clients want.

Can we choose the color of the background? Can we use our own background? Yes. Our default background is white. But we also offer backgrounds in red, blue, pink, gray, purple and green. If you wish to use your own background make sure it is at least 4 feet wide and 9 feet long.



We would like the outside of the booth to be a certain color to match the decor of our reception/party/venue is this possible? Can you make custom booth sides with pictures and graphics on them? No, all of our booths are black or a dark navy blue; these conservative colors will compliment any decor.

Does an attendant come with the rental? Yes, he or she will set up the booth and answer any questions guests have as well as take the booth down at the end of the night. That being said the booth is self explanatory and an attendant is not really needed since instructions are clearly displayed on the large LCD computer display inside the booth.

How much will it cost to deliver the booth to my event? Generally speaking we try to make delivery free if you live within 45 minutes or so of a metropolitan area, whether it be the New York City metro area or the Washington, DC area.

Do you have liability insurance? My venue has old historic floors and walls and is worried about a heavy booth scratching or marring the decor. Yes we are insured. However, rest assured , we have never run into an issue where there was property damage. Our booths weigh 80 pounds. Most old fashioned chemical booths from the 1950's weigh 700 pounds and that is why many venue people cringe when they hear you want a photo booth.

What happens if there is a mechanical problem with the booth? Well since our booths are digital there simply is no such thing as a mechanical problem. Old chemical booths used motors and chains to develop photo strips. Our modern digital booths use computers, cameras and printers to produce higher quality results. Our booths are contractually guaranteed to run 80% of the time. They occasionally need paper and supplies replenished, otherwise they work non stop.

What is the difference between the digital photo booths your company rents and a classic chemical photo booth?

Basically the speed and output of the images. Our modern digital photobooths can produce an array out output photos that range in size from 2x6" strips to 3"x8" strips to 4x6" prints to 8x10" prints. The biggest advantage of the digital booth though is that it stores all the photos as digital files which can be reprinted and viewed later on.
